

Maury County Comprehensive Plan Area Definitions and Meeting Dates

Area 1: Santa Fe/ Northwest Maury: Meeting was held September 16.

Area 2: West Maury County: Meeting on Tuesday, November 18, 6pm at Hampshire School.

This area is broadly defined as being along either side of Hwy 412/99 from the County line on the west to Canaan Road on the east; north to Sawdust to and south to Allensville. This area includes Hampshire and Cross Bridges.

Area 3: Mt. Pleasant: Meeting on Tuesday, December 9, 6pm at Mt. Pleasant Community Center

This area is broadly defined as being along either side of Hwy. 43/243 from Hamilton Court on the east to the County Line on the west, north to Allensville, and south to the County line. In addition to Mt. Pleasant, this area includes Mount Joy, Porters Chapel, Rockdale, Sandy Hook, Enterprise, and Spencer Hill

Area 4: West Columbia: Meeting on Tuesday, October 14, 6 pm at Columbia State

This area is broadly defined as being along Hwy 423/Trotwood Ave. bounded on the east by James Campbell Blvd and Industrial Park Rd., on the west by Canaan Road, south by Sunnyside Ln., and north by Highway 50. This area includes Sunnyside, Graymere, Columbia State, Zion Rd., etc.

Area 5: South Urban Growth Area: Meetings were held August 28 and July 24.

Area 6: South/Southeast Maury County: Meeting on Tuesday, October 14, 6pm at Culleoka School

This area is broadly defined as enclosed by the Campbellsville Pike on the west, County line on the south and west, and Sowell Mill Pike on the north. This area includes Bigbyville, Stiversville, Campbells Station, Culleoka, Bryant Station, and Fountain Heights.

Area 7: Central Columbia: Meeting on Tuesday, October 28, 6 pm at Memorial Bldg.

This area is broadly defined as the core of Columbia. It is bounded on the north by Hwy 7, James Campbell Blvd. on the west and south, and Tom Hitch Parkway on the east. The northern boundary includes the Riverside subdivision.

Area 8: North Columbia/Spring Hill Corridor: Meeting on Tuesday, December 9, 6 pm at Middle TN Ag. Exp. Station

This area is broadly defined as being a corridor along either side of Hwy. 31, bounded on the north by Saturn Pkwy., on the south by the Duck River bridge into Columbia, on the west by Carters Creek/ Theta Pike, and on the east by a line drawn between Randolph Howell Elementary on Hwy 412 and the intersection of Kedron Rd. and Saturn Pkwy.

Area 9: Spring Hill: Meeting on Tuesday, October 28, 6 pm at Spring Hill City Hall

This area is broadly defined as Spring Hill City limits on south to the county line on the north, east to the County line and west to Petty Lane.

Area 10: East Columbia/East Central Maury County: Meeting on Tuesday, November 18, 6 pm at Cox Middle School

This area is broadly defined as bounded on the west by Tom Hitch Pkwy., County line on east, Sowell Mill Pike on the south, and Greens Mill Rd. on the north.
