

Maury County Park Shelters/Pavilions

Name of Pavilion	Capacity	Directions and Amenities
Kiwanis	125	Beside Kids' Kingdom playground. Restrooms, Fireplace, Water, Grill & Electricity.
Bridle & Saddle	75	Go past Babe Ruth fields down and across from Kids' Kingdom. Newest shelter (2010). Across the street from Kids' Kingdom playground. Restrooms, Fireplace, Water, Grill, Electricity.
White Oak	40	Behind Kids' Kingdom. Take a right before pulling in to playground and go across railroad tracks. Grill, Water, Electricity, Swings.
Civitan	60	Go past Kids' Kingdom playground. Take a right, then the next left into parking lot. It is the smaller shelter on the left. Grill, Water, Electricity. Restrooms and Toddler playground across the parking lot.
Jr. Order	125	Go past Kids' Kingdom. Take a right, then the next left into parking lot. It is the larger shelter at the end of the parking lot. Grill, Water, Electricity. Restrooms and Toddler playground before shelter.
Rotary	125	These shelters sit side-by-side. Go past Kids' Kingdom and take a right. Go to the end of the road. For larger groups, these two shelters can be rented together. Jared's Dream playground across the parking lot. Tony's Trail to the left of shelters. Both shelters have Water, Electricity and Grills. Additional swings behind Rotary shelter.

Monsanto/Deck	75	Go up the winding road all the way to the top of the hill. Grill, Water & Electricity. CURRENTLY CLOSED FOR RESERVATIONS. RESTROOMS CLOSED.

Gazebo	Go past Kids' Kingdom and take a right. The gazebo for 8 is on the left and is first-come, first-serve. Small grill.

Playgrounds	Kiwanis - Kids' Kingdom - CURRENTLY UNDER RENOVATION Civitan & Jr. Order - Orange & White Plastic Toddler Rotary & Jaycee - Jared's Dream Swings are scattered throughout the park
