UPDATED COVID-19 POLICY

EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY

Due to the National Pandemic, COVID-19 (Corona Virus) and in accordance with Supreme Court Order, the Maury County Chancery Court/Clerk and Master's Office will follow protocol ordered by the Tennessee Supreme Court and the approved plan for the Twenty-Second Judicial District, to limit person to person contact as much as possible.

Our office is open and we can accommodate two (2) people at a time for filing and payment of taxes and court filings.

If you do not need an "in-person" appointment for probate filing, please continue to use the drop box at the security check point or mail your filing to our office.

If you need to schedule an "in-person" probate filing, please call or email in advance as it is difficult to secure a court room or other room sufficient to maintain the protocol in place due to COVID-19.

Passport application acceptance is suspended until further notice. Please file your application with the U.S. Postal Service.

Our staff will be in the office, Monday through Friday (8:00 a.m. through 4:00 p.m.) and available by telephone, email and fax.
